Billy Marvin Stevenson was born December 8, 1931 and died peacefully at St. Thomas Rutherford Hospital in Murfreesboro, on Saturday, May 20, 2017.

Funeral services will be 10 AM Tuesday, May 23, 2017, at Midland Heights Baptist Church. Pastor Scott Reed will officiate. Burial, with full military honors, will follow in Willow Mount Cemetery.
