Mr. David E. Presley, age 66, of Shelbyville, passed away Friday, July 15, 2016.

Funeral services, with full military honors, will be 5 PM Monday, July 18, 2016, at First Assembly of God. Reverend Glenn Forsee and Reverend Eddie Reed will officiate.

Per his request, he will be cremated following the service.

The family will receive visitors 2 PM until service time Monday at the church.
