David Milton Renegar, age 79, of Shelbyville, passed away at home with his loving family on December 14, 2021.

Funeral services will be 11 A.M. Friday, December 17, 2021, at Feldhaus Memorial Chapel with burial to follow at Hillcrest Memorial Gardens. Reverend Jeff Rasnick will officiate. Visitation will be Thursday evening from 3:00 P.M. to 6:00 P.M.

David was born October 3, 1942, in Bedford County, to the late Otto Kenneth and Mary Ruth Cowan Renegar. He graduated from Shelbyville Central High School. He was a lifelong member of the First Baptist Church of Shelbyville. He also was an Eagle Scout. He served in the United States Air Force for 4 years and retired from Bellsouth after 38 years. David was always helping others, including serving many years with the Optimist and Lions Clubs and with the Boy Scouts as a Scout Master, manning the election polls in Bedford County, and being a part of many other volunteer activities. He spent countless hours working on the family farm and in various jobs even after his official retirement.

He is preceded in death by his brother, Ottie Charles Renegar.

He is survived by his wife of 55 years Betty Ellis Renegar and daughters,
