Mr. Gary Tenery Odeneal, age 67, of Shelbyville, passed away Tuesday, May 6, 2014, at his home after an extended illness.

Funeral services will be 11 AM Friday, May 9, 2014, at Feldhaus Memorial Chapel. Pastor Don Jones will officiate. Burial, with full military honors, will follow in Hillcrest Memorial Gardens.
