Mr. George Henderson Clanton, age 89, of Shelbyville, passed away Saturday, January 25, 2014.

Funeral services will be 2 PM Monday, January 27, 2014, at Feldhaus Memorial Chapel. Burial, with full military honors will follow in Hillcrest Memorial Gardens.

Visitation will be 4-8 PM Sunday at Feldhaus Memorial Chapel.
