



Mr. George W. Sinquefield

October 26, 1920 - November 10, 2015

Mr. George W. Sinquefield, age 95, of Shelbyville, passed away, Tuesday, November 10, 2015, at his home after an extended illness.

Funeral Services will be 1:30 PM Thursday, November 12, 2015, at Eastview Baptist Church. Reverend Kenny Collins will officiate, with burial to follow in Hurricane Grove Cemetery.

The family will receive visitors 12:30 until service time Thursday at the church.

He was born October 26, 1920, in Barbour County, Alabama, to the late Carl and Eva Loveless Sinquefield. Reverend Sinquefield pastored Baptist Churches for over fifty years, spending six years in Illinois, Ohio, and Michigan starting new churches. An Air Force Veteran of World War II, he was the recipient of the World War II Victory Medal, Good Conduct Medal, and American Service Medal. He loved his family and friends. He held membership in Eastview Baptist Church.

Preceding his death were a brother, Ben Sinquefield, and a sister, Margaret Cox.

Survivors include his wife of 67 years, Evelyn Gillespie Sinquefield, of Shelbyville; four sons, Steven (Kandy) Sinquefield, of Lutz, Florida, Walter

Sinquefield and Stanley (Penny) Sinquefield, both of Huntsville, Alabama, and Roger (Mary Jane) Sinquefield, of Shelbyville; a brother, Douglas Sinquefield, of Silva, North Carolina; two grandchildren, McLain Sinquefield and Sam Sinquefield, of Shelbyville.
