



Ms Glendon Dale Nichols

May 28, 1930 - March 20, 2020

Glendon Dale Nichols died on March 20, 2020, at the age of 89. Ms. Nichols was born on May 28, 1930, in Petersburg, Tennessee, where she lived during her childhood and teenage years. She attended Morgan Preparatory School in Petersburg. After graduation from Morgan Preparatory School in 1949, Ms. Nichols attended Memphis State University (now, the University of Memphis) where she received a Bachelor of Science Degree in Home Economics with a minor in Chemistry. Upon graduating from Memphis State in 1953, she began working for Tennessee Valley Authority in its chemistry lab located in Florence, Alabama. Ms. Nichols later transferred to Tennessee Valley Authority's Knoxville office where she served as a home economist. As a home economist, she demonstrated to citizens in rural communities energy saving methods and strategies. Ms. Nichols retired from Tennessee Valley Authority and spent her retirement years gardening and painting at her home in Tellico Village.

Ms. Nichols was the daughter of the late Charles Burton Nichols and Lillian Dale Sorrells Nichols. She is survived by her sister Nina N. Lambert, her nephew, Jody (Sara Jo) Lambert, a great-nephew, Mack Lambert, a great-niece, Sara Beth (Austin) Lambert Scott, a great-great-nephew, Knox Scott, and a great-great-niece, Sutton Scott.
