Mr. Henry Benton Warden, age 93, of Shelbyville, passed away Thursday, December 25, 2014, at his home after an extended illness.

Funeral services will be 12 noon Saturday, December 27, 2014, at Feldhaus Memorial Chapel. Reverend Tom Tyndall will officiate, with burial to follow in Rose Bank Cemetery in the Flat Creek Community.
