“*My Dad was the ultimate Dad! He was patient and caring. He always listened to me and would reflect before he answered back. He gave me the best advice for me and my problems throughout the years. He taught me how to play sports and he taught me how to get back up again if life knocked you down. I have so many things I am grateful to my Dad for teaching me. He was a wonderful teacher. He taught thousands of air traffic control students at the academy, he taught flying safety courses at Quantico, he taught people to fly at Wiley Post, Oklahoma and Tullahoma, Tennessee. My Dad besides being a wonderful father, worked for his fellow Americans in the Navy, at Indianapolis ARTCC for 31 years as an air traffic controller and when he retired he went to work almost 10 years at the academy teaching ATC students as well as training pilots at Wiley Post. He then moved to Tennessee and continued to teach pilots at Tullahoma. He became more involved with his church as he slowed from teaching and spent his last few years being taken over by Parkinsons. Dad fought to keep his mobility and even recovered from his broken neck this spring, but when he broke his neck again he just didn't have any strength left. He also had another draw to the other side, my Mom, his wife of 62 years passed 3 years ago and he had missed her terribly. My Dad was an exceptional human being and I will be grateful till the day I pass that God allowed me to be his daughter. My only consolation is my parents are now together for eternity. All my love for who you helped me become!*”
