Mr. James Glenn Helton, age 83, of Shelbyville, passed away Monday, February 9, 2015, after a lengthy battle with Parkinson's disease.

Funeral services will be 1 PM Thursday, February 12, 2015, at Feldhaus Memorial Chapel. Reverend Mark Hall will officiate. Burial, with full military honors, will follow in Smotherman Cemetery.

The family will receive visitors 10:30 AM Thursday until service time.
