Mr. Jerome Stone Williams, age 69, of Shelbyville, passed away Tuesday, April 14, 2020.

A private graveside service will be held Saturday, April 18, 2020, at Willow Mount Cemetery. Pastor Jason Scales will officiate.

The body will lie in state from 8:00 A.M. to 4:00 P.M. Friday, April 17, 2020, at the Feldhaus Memorial Chapel. In efforts to adhere to CDC guidelines, only ten people will be allowed in the funeral home at a time. Visitors are welcome to sign the register book, get a memorial record, and view the body. The family will not be present.

He was born February 7, 1951, in Nashville, to Mary Williams. Jerome was a member of Scott's United Methodist Church where he gave his life to Christ. He was retired from Calsonic as a fork lift operator, enjoyed fishing, and was a veteran of the United States Army.

He is preceded in death by his brother, James Andre Connors.

He is survived by his mother, Mary Williams, of Shelbyville; three sons: Jerome Williams, Jr., of Tampa, Florida, James Turrentine, of Shelbyville, and Jeremy Lentz, of Shelbyville; a daughter, Jernika (Raymond) Frazier,

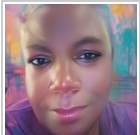
