Mr. Kerry Limbaugh, age 57, of Shelbyville, passed away Sunday, October 25, 2020, at his home under the loving care and comfort of his family and Alive Hospice.

Funeral services will be 2 PM Wednesday, October 28, 2020, at First Baptist Church at 304 Depot Street, Shelbyville, Tn,37160. Reverend Jeff Rasnick will officiate, with burial to follow in Willow Mount Cemetery.
