She was the last of her siblings to pass. She departed this earthly life and transitioned into eternal life on May 6, 2020, at home with her loved ones surrounded by her side.

Margaret gave her life to Christ at an early age and was a member of St. Paul A.M.E. Church in Wartrace, Tennessee, where she served as a choir member, church secretary, and president of the Usher Board. She was a faithful and dedicated member of the church until it closed.
