



## Mr. Ronnie Lynn Cook

October 12, 1957 - September 3, 2014

Ronnie Lynn Cook (b. October 12, 1957) of Shelbyville died Wednesday, September 3, at Vanderbilt University Medical Center following a brief illness. Mr. Cook was a longtime route salesman for R. C. Cola, Beamon Bottling Company, and Prescott Bottling and Distributing Company, as well as fountain service manager for Prescott. Recently, he had worked for Home Healthcare of Middle Tennessee and At Home Healthcare, and he loved, and was loved by, the patients whom he visited.
