Mr. Roy Edward Locke, age 98, of Shelbyville, passed away Friday, April 17, 2015.

Funeral services will be 11 AM Monday, April 20, 2015, at Feldhaus Memorial Chapel. Reverend Doug Dezotell will officiate. Burial, with full military honors, will follow in Hillcrest Memorial Gardens.

The family will receive visitors 2-5 PM Sunday at the funeral home.

He was born November 21, 1916, in Moore County, to the late Robert Lee and Mattie Elkins Locke. He was a farmer by trade, and retired after 25 years from Uniroyal. Mr. Locke was involved with the "Meals on Wheels" program for over 25 years. He served in the Army during World War II in the European Theatre. He was a lifelong Methodist, and maintained membership at Cannon United Methodist Church.

He was preceded in death by his wife, Eloise Allen Locke, a sister, Francis Locke Troxler, and a grandson, Russell Matthew Locke.

Survivors include his son, Keith (Lana) Locke, of Shelbyville; a sister, Jean Locke Stimpson, of the Flat Creek Community; granddaughter, Sarah Locke (Kyle Adams); two great grandchildren, Kaleb Locke and Zoey Locke.
